

NIRA lideri projekt: - "Izgradnja roditeljske kuće u Zenici" - Udruženje "ZADA", Zenica

U okviru NIRA lideri projekta koji je implementirala TPO Fondacija u obliku četverodnevno treninga za lični i profesionalni razvoj, učesnice su bile i članice Udruženja "Zada" iz Zenice. Članice Udruženja "Zada" predstavljaju marginaliziranu skupinu žena Zeničko - dobojskog kantona koje su izrazile potrebu za ovakvom vrstom treninga jer se bave građanskim aktivizmom. Nakon što su prošle obuku pisanja projekta, aplicirale su za Nira lideri projekte kod TPO Fondacije. Tri projekta ispred Udruženja "Zada" su dobila sredstva za realizaciju svojih projektnih ideja. Treći projekt "Izgradnja roditeljske kuće u Zenici" se realizovao od augusta do novembra 2019. godine. Koordinatorica projekta je bila Muamera Husetović ispred Udruženja.

Glavni cilj projekta: Glede činjenice da veliki broj djece obolijeva u Zeničko - dobojskom kantonu i da ne postoji mogućnost da roditelji borave sa djecom u bolnici jer nema dovoljno mjesta, važno je da djeca imaju roditelje blizu kada su bolesna i u bolnici jer to smanjuje stres i omogućava bolji i brži oporavak.

Održane aktivnosti:

Aktivnost 1. Pripremni sastanak na kojem je učestvovalo 16 žena iz Udruženja. Na sastanku su raspoređene aktivnosti i zaduženja. 19.8.2019.

Aktivnost 2. Seminar o zagovaranju i lobiranju. Predavačica je bila doktorica Amela Granić koja je i političarka. Ona će pomoći da se projekt predstavi na Grdskom vijeću. Na seminaru su članice naučile kako zagovarati i lobirati kod vlasti zarad ostvarenja građanskih prava oboljele djece i njihovih roditelja koji ne mogu plaćati privatni smještaj za vrijeme boravka djeteta u bolnici te kako realizirati peticiju.

Aktivnost 3. Dizajniranje promotivnog materijala. Prije nego je krenulo potpisivanje peticije, dizajnirani su promotivni plakati i lifleti na kojima se nalaze osnovne informacije o tome šta znači i zašto je važno imati roditeljsku kuću.

Aktivnost 4. Peticija za izgradnju roditeljske kuće. Peticija se potpisivala na glavnoj gradskoj ulici kao i na selima. Tokom potpisivanja peticije, građanima su se dijeli promotivni materijali. Cilj je iskupiti 5000 potpisa.

Aktivnost 5. Lobiranje. Organiziranje sastanaka i susreta sa političarima koji mogu uticati na to da se donese odluka o izgradnji roditeljske kuće na kojima će im se predati kopije peticije.

Mnogi su ljudi bili oduševljeni idejom projekta "Izgradnje roditeljske kuće" te su doveli prijatelje i roditelje da se potpišu. Neki su čak nudili i donacije. Jedini problem koji se javio jeste da određeni ljudi podržavaju ideju ali su nepovjerljivi za davanje svojih osnovnih podataka i potpisa.

NIRA Leaders Project: - "**Building a Parental House in Zenica**" - "ZADA"
Association, Zenica

Within the NIRA leaders of the project implemented by the TPO Foundation in the form of a four-day training for personal and professional development, the participants were also members of the Zada Association "Zada". Members of the "Zada" Association represent a marginalized group of women from the Zenica - Doboj Canton who have expressed a need for this type of training because they are engaged in civic activism. After completing the project writing training, they applied for Nira project leaders with the TPO Foundation. Three projects in front of the Association "Zada" have received funds for the realization of their project ideas. The third project "**Building a Parental House in Zenica**" was implemented from August to November 2019. The project coordinator was Muamera Husetović in front of the Association.

The main goal of the project: Considering the fact that a large number of children get sick in the Zenica - Doboj Canton and that there is no possibility for parents to stay with their children in the hospital because there is not enough space, it is important that children have parents close to themselves when they are ill and lying in the hospital for the sake of reducing stress and enabling better and faster recovery.

Activities held:

Activity 1. A preparatory meeting attended by 16 women from the Association. Activities and tasks were assigned at the meeting. 19 August 2019.

Activity 2. Seminar on advocacy and lobbying. The lecturer was doctor Amela Granić, who is also a politician. She will help to present the project to the City Council. At the seminar, members of "ZADA" learned how to advocate and lobby the authorities for the sake of civil rights of sick children and of their parents who cannot pay for private accommodation during their child's stay in hospital and they learned how to petition.

Activity 3. Designing promotional material. Before the petition was signed, promotional posters and leaflets were designed to provide basic information about what it means and why it is important to have a parental home.

Activity 4. Petition for building a parental home. The petition was being signed on the main city street as well as in the villages. During the signing of the petition, promotional materials were distributed to citizens. The goal is to collect 5000 signatures.

Activity 5. Lobbying. Organizing meetings and encounters with politicians that may influence the decision to build a parental home where copies of the petition will be handed to them.

Many people were delighted with the idea of the project "**Building a Parental House**" and were bringing friends and parents to sign. Some even offered donations. The only problem that has arisen is that certain people support the idea but are distrustful of providing their basic information and signatures.
