

NIRA Lideri projekt – „Siguran prostor za mlade“ – Nerdžis Čaplja, Univerzitet u Zenici

Oni koji donose svjetlost u tuđe živote nikad ne hodaju u mraku.

TPO Fondacija je, u okviru Nira Lideri projekta, nakon četverodnevnog treninga za lični i profesionalni razvoj, studentima i studenticama Univerziteta u Tuzli i Univerziteta u Zenici, dodijelila pet grantova za najbolje projektne prijedloge. Jedan od tih najboljih projektnih prijedloga jeste projekt „Siguran prostor za mlade“ koji je trajao od augusta do novembra 2019. Koordinatorica ovog projekta u okviru NIRA Lideri projekta je bila Nerdžis Čaplja sa Univerziteta u Zenici. Projekt je nastavak Public Speech koji se realizovao 2017. godine u sklopu projekta SMART koji je organizirala Unija Studenata UNZE.

Glavni cilj projekta je građanski aktivizam mladih osoba grada Zenice i ZDK te zagovaranje društvenih, konstruktivnih, pozitivnih na društveni razvoj orijentiranih promjena.

Održane aktivnosti:

Aktivnost 1. Promocija na društvenim mrežama. U realizaciju ove aktivnosti bilo je uključeno 5 mladih ljudi od 20 - 25 godina. Aktivnost je realizirana na način da su održana 3 sastanka na kojima je dogovoren plan realizacije promocije na društvenim mrežama. Plan se sastojao od pravljenja stranice na Instagramu i Facebooku, slanja poziva medijima za praćenje i izvještavanje sa centralne aktivnosti pod nazivom „Mladi govore o problemima mladih“ i sloganom „Riješi problem i kreiraj promjenu“. Drugi dio je bio izvještaj o centralnoj aktivnosti projekta, a treći je bio PR izvještaj planiran za osnivanje organizacije.

Aktivnost 2. Centralna aktivnost projekta. Centralna aktivnost projekta je realizovana 24.10.2019. Učešće za govor je preuzeila samo jedna mlada osoba od planiranih trideset. Program aktivnosti smo proširili sa razgovorom sa panelistima, ministrom za obrazovanje, kulturu i sport ZDK Spahijom Kozlićem, psihologom Sedinom Habibovićem i Mirzom Džananovićem o problemima mladih u lokalnoj zajednici, razlozima za pasivnost mladih ljudi i pitanjem da li mladi u ovoj zajednici imaju probleme.

Poziv na centralnu aktivnost projekta je poslana i lokalnim nevladinim organizacijama da se javno predstave kroz pitanje „Kako kroz svoje djelovanje rješavaju probleme mladih u lokalnoj zajednici?“ Na poziv se odazvao predstavnik organizacije "Azimuth 135" koja se bavi sportskim planiranjem i kulturnom afirmacijom u Zenici.

Aktivnost je bila upotpunjena i kulturnim sadržajima kao što su: ples sambe i ča ča ča u izvedbi Kenana Bajramovića i Taiše Mlinarić iz plesnog studija „Shadows“ i tango plesom u izvedbi Vanese Đukić i Vinka Dujaka iz plesnog kluba „Tango Quimera“.

Aktivnost 3. Osnivanje nevladine organizacije. Aktivnost je u toku. Trenutno kreiramo statut organizacije.

Pet mladih ljudi iz Zenice je preuzeo stvari u svoje ruke, pokušali su da adresiraju probleme u lokalnoj zajednici. Iako je urađena kvalitetna promocija projekta u preko 20 medijskih poruka, odaziv nije bio na očekivanom nivou. Pohvalno je što su organizatori našli način da popune centralnu aktivnost neovisno o broju učesnika. Dobro je pitanje da li mladi u ovoj lokalnoj zajednici imaju probleme, i ako ih imaju zašto su pasivni? Ovaj projekt dokazuje da su mladi ljudi u Zenici pasivni, što pokazuje nešto o mladima a ne o organizatorima koji su se potrudili da daju mladima prostor za govor o svojim problemima. Jako je bitno da je na projektu učestvovao i ministar za obrazovanje, nauku i mlade ZDK, što znači da su mladi direktno mogli da iskažu i prezentuju svoje probleme na pravu adresu.

NIRA Leaders Project – „The Safe Space for Youth“ – Nerdžis Čaplja, the University of Zenica

Those who bring light into others' lives never walk in the dark.

After four days of training for personal and professional development, TPO Foundation awarded five grants to the students of the University of Tuzla and the University of Zenica for the best project proposals as the part of the NIRA Leaders Project. One of these best project proposals was the project named “The Safe Space for Youth”. It lasted from August to November 2019. The coordinator of this project within the NIRA Leaders Project was Nerdžis Čaplja, student of the University of Zenica. The project is a continuation of the Public Speech realized in 2017 as the part of the SMART project organized by the UNZE Student Union.

The main goal of the project is civic activism of young people of Zenica and of ZDC, and advocacy of social, constructive, positively oriented changes on social development.

Activities held:

Activity 1. Promotion on social networks. Five young people aged 20 - 25 were involved in this activity. The activity was organized in such a way that three meetings were held at which the plan of realization of social networks promotion was agreed. The plan consisted of creating a page on Instagram and Facebook, sending invitations to the media to monitor and report from the central activity called "Youth talk about Youth Issues" and the slogan "Solve a Problem and

Create a Change". The second part was a report on the central activity of the project, and a third was PR report planned for the establishment of the organization.

Activity 2. The central activity of the project. The central activity of the project has been realised on 24 October 2019. Only one young person out of thirty planned appeared to participate in the speech. We expanded our program of activities by talking to panellists, ZDC Minister of Education, Culture and Sports Spahija Kozlić, psychologist Sedin Habibović and Mirza Džananović about youth issues in the local community, reasons for young people's passivity and wondering whether young people in this community have problems.

We sent the call for the central activity of the project to local NGOs to present themselves publicly through the question "How do they solve youth problems in the local community through their actions?" Association "Azimuth 135" representative, dealing with sports planning and cultural affirmation in Zenica, responded to the call.

The activity was complemented by cultural activities such as: dancing samba and cha cha cha performed by Kenan Bajramović and Taiša Mlinarić from Dance studio "Shadows" and tango dance performed by Vanesa Đukić and Vinko Dujak from Dance club "Tango Quimera".

Activity 3. Establishment of an NGO. Activity is ongoing. We are currently creating an organization statute.

Five young people from Zenica took the action and tried to address problems in the local community. Although high quality promotion of the project was done in over 20 media messages, the response was not as expected. It is praiseworthy that the organizers have found a way to complete the central activity regardless of the number of participants. The good question is, do young people in this local community have problems, and if so, why are they passive? This project proves that young people in Zenica are passive, which proves something about young people and not about the organizers who tried to give young people a space to talk about their problems. It is very important that the Minister of Education, Science and Youth of the ZDC also participated in the project, which means that young people were able to express and present their problems directly to the right address.
